# **The Third Sorrowful Mystery** The Crowning with Thorns

## Hail Mary...

With revilement and torture let us put him to the test / that we may have proof of his gentleness / and try his patience. *Wis 2:19* 

Hail Mary...

Seek not from the LORD authority, / nor from the king a place of honor. / Parade not your justice before the LORD, / and before the king flaunt not your wisdom. ... Be swift to hear, / but slow to answer. *Sir 7:4-5, Sir 5:13* 

## Hail Mary...

[T]hey stripped him of the long tunic he had on ... [and] dipped the tunic in its blood. ... [F]alse charges in public, trial before all the people, / and lying testimony are harder to bear than death. *Gn 37:23,31, Sir 26:5* 

## Hail Mary...

A faithful God, without deceit, / how just and upright he is! / Yet basely has he been treated by his degenerate children, / a perverse and crooked race! *Dt* 32:4-5

"I am who am." ... Even to the death fight for truth, / and the LORD your God will battle for you. *Ex 3:14, Sir 4:28*
