The Third Glorious Mystery The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Our Father...

To the Israelites the glory of the LORD was seen as a consuming fire on the mountaintop. ... It was always so: during the day the Dwelling was covered by the cloud, which at night had the appearance of fire. *Ex* 24:17, *Nm* 9:16

Out of the heavens he let you hear his voice to discipline you; on earth he let you see his great fire, and you heard him speaking out of the fire. *Dt* 4:36

Hail Mary...

[F]ix in your heart, that the LORD is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other. *Dt 4:39*

The LORD, our God, has indeed let us see his glory and his majesty! We have heard his voice from the midst of the fire. ... Taking some of the spirit that was on Moses, he bestowed it on the seventy elders; and as the spirit came to rest on them, they prophesied. *Dt 5:24, Nm 11:25*

Hail Mary...

For the LORD, your God, is a consuming fire, a jealous God. *Dt 4:24*

Hail Mary...

Ever present in your midst, I will be your God, and you will be my people; for it is I, the LORD, your God, who brought you out of the land of the Egyptians. *Lv 26:12-13*

For the spirit of the LORD fills the world, / is all-embracing, and knows what man says. *Wis 1:7*

Let your spirits rejoice in the mercy of God, / and be not ashamed to give him praise. *Sir 51:29*
