Our Father...

And the soldiers wove a crown out of thorns and placed it on his head, and clothed him in a purple cloak. *Jn 19:2*

Hail Mary...

According to the law almost everything is purified by blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. *Heb 9:22*

Hail Mary...

[T]hey came to him and said, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they struck him repeatedly. *Jn 19:3*

Hail Mary...

He has a name written on his cloak and on his thigh, "King of kings and Lord of lords." *Rv 19:16*

Hail Mary...

He wore a cloak that had been dipped in blood. *Rv 19:13*

Hail Mary...

So Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple cloak. And [Pilate] said to them, "Behold, the man!" ... [T]hey cried out, "Crucify him, crucify him!" *Jn 19:5-6*

Hail Mary...

Pilate said to him, "Do you not speak to me? Do you not know that I have power to release you and I have power to crucify you?" *Jn 19:10*

Hail Mary...

Jesus answered [him], "You would have no power over me if it had not been given to you from above." *Jn 19:11*

Hail Mary...

Pilate said to them, "Shall I crucify your king?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but Caesar." *Jn 19:15*
